Percent of adults, age 18 and older, registered to vote.

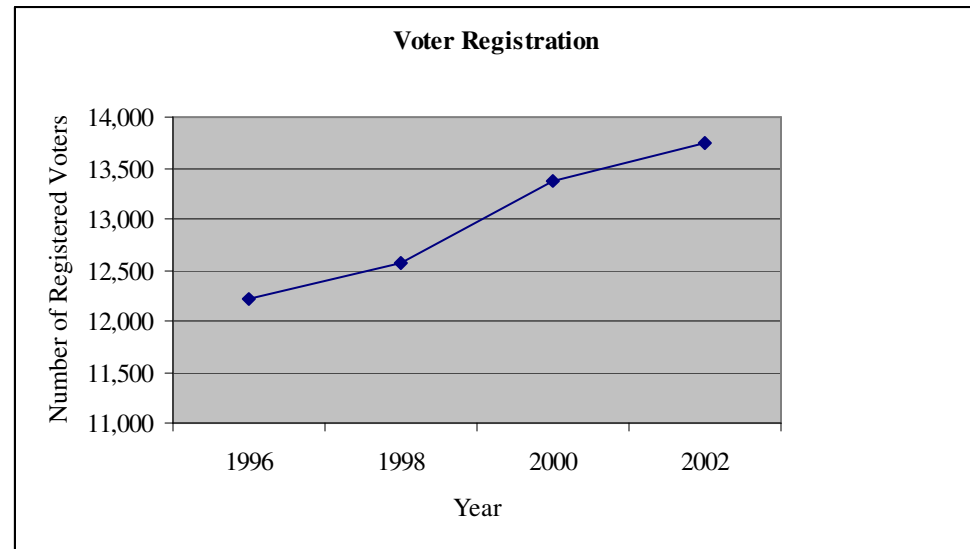
Analysis:

Voter registration in Wakulla County has been consistently on the rise since 1996. In the last four years, voter registration has increased by 13%. Similar to Leon County and the State, voter registration tends to be higher in the Presidential election years than in the Gubernatorial.

Indicator 2: Voter Turnout

Indicator:

Percentage of registered voters who voted in general elections.

Analysis:

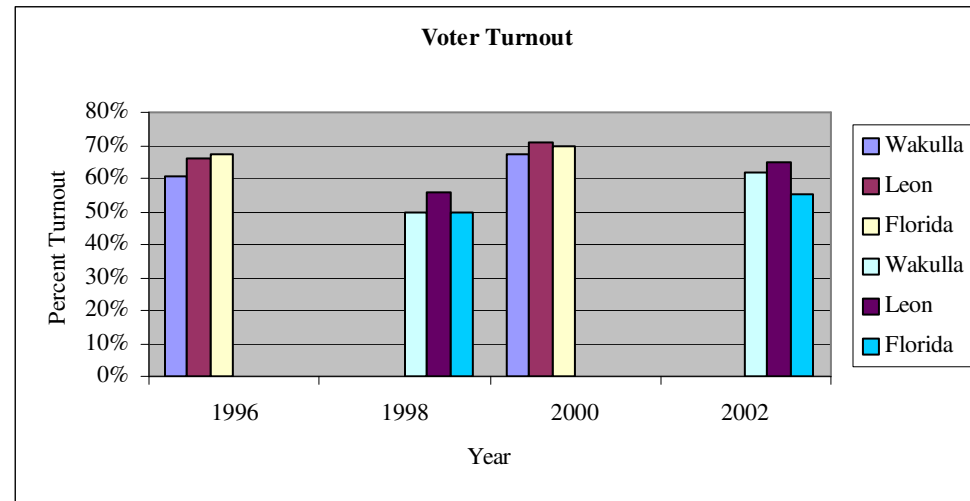
Generally, Wakulla County’s voter turnout has been highest in Presidential elections and lowest in municipal elections. It is significantly higher than statewide turnout in Gubernatorial elections.

However, the increment in voter turnout in the Gubernatorial election has increased considerably more than in the Presidential elections (12% vs. 7%).
